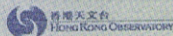

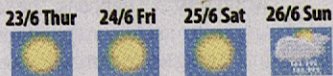

## Local photography icon dies

Acclaimed Hong Kong photographer Ho Fan, renowned for capturing light and shadows, particularly in his pictures of old Hong Kong, has died. He was 84.

Ho was surrounded by his family when he died on June 19 in a San Jose hospital in California from complications following a bout of pneumonia.

In his award-winning career that spanned 70 years, Ho won nearly 300

photography awards. Ho was born in Shanghai and started taking photographs at the age of 14. After moving to Hong Kong in 1949, it was his portrayal of Hong Kong in the 1950s and 60s that brought him international acclaim.

He was also an actor at Shaw Brothers film studio in the 1960s and directed more than 20 movies in the following two decades. He migrated to the United States in the 1990s.
